Enriching Lives and Building the Community Award: Individual

Recognizing exceptional individuals who go way beyond what could reasonably be expected of them, to improve the lives of citizens or communities. Their contributions could be in the workplace, or as volunteers outside work, or both. We are looking for

- Nominees with a passion and commitment to making a difference, while maintaining high standards in their service to the community
- Nominees whose contributions have a substantial and positive impact.

Mind, Body & Spirit : Group or Individual

Recognizing people who have made a highly effective contribution to promoting or improving health and wellbeing within the church and the community. We will be looking for:

- Successful interventions to improve health and wellbeing with a positive and quantifiable outcome;
- Innovative approaches to promoting or measuring positive mental or physical wellbeing;
- Nominees who create a great place to work and inspire others to do the same.

The Watson Award: Group or Individual

Recognizing excellent collaboration that spans the boundaries between sectors, administrations, or layers of groups. We will be looking for:

- Nominees whose work has put the church or community first, ahead of narrow interests;
- Investment in relationships or process improvement, so that foundations have been laid for future joint working relationships
- Working in partnership: has the nominee introduced effective joint-working arrangements that bring together colleagues from multiple teams, departments or other internal or external organizations.

Inspirational Leadership Award: Individual

Recognizing individuals who have demonstrated outstanding leadership, regardless of position or role. We will be looking for:

- Nominees who inspire others.
- An inclusive, confident and engaging approach.
- Strong evidence that the nominee's leadership is linked to improved performance by their organization.

Social Courage Award: Individual

Recognizing individuals who stand up for moral principles and render service to humanity without regard for personal or professional peril. Recipients positively affect public discourse despite the risk to their careers, their livelihoods, and even their lives.

Volunteer of Excellence: Group or Individual

Recognizing volunteers who have contributed outstanding service while partnering directly with us in any pathway to implement the BMBC & BCFLC Experience or who contributed outstanding service in support of our mission delivery goals.

Innovation Award: Group or Individual

Innovative: has the nominee used innovative approaches and made the best use of the technology available, resulting in a step up from business as usual and real benefits to end users?

- Impact: has the nominee made an impact beyond their immediate team/business area/department.

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
