

Database Structure

Please refer to the diagram of the database structure below when completing the Beulah Census form.

Household

The database is designed to store information regarding a member's residence location. The location is referred to as the "Household".

*Head of House hold 1 (HOH-1)

The head of household represents the adult head of the household. This is a required entry.

*Head of House hold 2 (HOH-2)

The head of household represents the second adult head of the household. This is an **optional** entry if there is **only one adult** head of household.

Minor Child

Indicates the minor living in the household is the **child** of at least one of the Heads of Household member(s).

Adult Child

Indicates the adult living in the household is the child of at least one of the Heads of Household member(s).

Guest Child

Indicates the minor child living in the household **is not** the child of either head of household.

Other Adult

Indicates the adult living in the household **is not** the child of either head of household.

* as the chart indicates, there can be two (2) heads of households. For example, if the two adults are married, one would be listed as the Head of Household – 1 (HOH -1) and the other as Head of Household – 2 (HOH -2). It does not matter which is listed first.
