Certified Volunteer Requirements

STEPS TO CERTIFICATION FOR MINISTRY VOLUNTEERS:

STEP 1.

Meet Georgia Department Of Juvenile Justice Regional Youth Detention Centers Certification Requirements (Ages 12 thru 21 Years Old) as indicated below:

Ministry Volunteers must agree to:

- 1) Be 18 years old or older, a U.S. Citizen or Legal U.S. Resident
- 2) Complete the GA Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) Volunteer Application at:
<https://djj.state.ga.us/Employees/DJJDrupalPTSWebVolAppForm.aspx>
- 3) Complete/submit a DJJ Intel Check Form and provide a copy of Valid State ID, Driver's License, Social Security Card, or Passport - (Incarcerated Ministry initiated)
- 4) Complete Background Investigation - (DJJ initiated via email)
- 5) Complete Fingerprint Investigation - (DJJ initiated via email)
- 6) Complete Volunteer Online Orientation Training - (DJJ initiated via email)

Only GA DJJ Certified Volunteers are allowed inside GA DJJ Regional / Youth Detention Center secure facilities.

STEP 2.

Meet Beulah Missionary Baptist Church overall goal to take the Church Beyond The Walls.

- 1) Achieve GA DJJ Volunteer Certification status
- 2) Conduct scheduled Ministry Outreach / Volunteer Opportunities
